1. Collected data

When collecting and processing personal data, we comply with the legal requirements of the applicable data protection laws. The legal basis is Art. 13 para. 1 of the Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP) or, if applicable, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b and f GDPR.

1.1 General

Our Internet pages collect a number of general data with each visit. This general data and information are stored in the log files of the server. The following data is collected:

- IP-address
- Date and time of visit
- Time zone
- Content of request
- Access status/http status code
- Transferred data volume
- Website from which request originates
- Browser (incl. language and version)
- Operating system

When these general data are used, they are not assigned to a specific person. The collection of this data is technically necessary in order to display our website to you and to guarantee its stability and security.

1.2 Contacting us

2. Cookies

Our website may use so-called cookies, small text files that are stored on your computer and can be accessed from there.
